Adoption of Prior Minutes: Minutes for the March 16, 2016 Planning Commission Meeting were reviewed.

Commissioner Zollinger moved to "approve the minutes of the March 16, 2016 Commission Meeting." Commissioner Petersen seconded the motion, which carried with Knowles, Malmstrom, Petersen, Schaub and Zollinger in favor. No one opposed.

<u>Public Hearing to Discuss a Conditional Use Permit Request from Darlin Russell for a Body Art Home Business at 698 E 716 S:</u> Commissioner Malmstrom reviewed Ms. Russell's request by reading from her application.

Commissioner Knowles asked if the city had written approval from the property owner. Recorder Lind verified that Bill Carson had signed Ms. Russell's application. Ms. Russell reminded that the Health Department and fire inspector had done inspections of the facility in her home and said they are very pleased with how she had things set up.

There were no neighbors in attendance. Ms. Russell informed they have lived in the home for six years and they get along great with their neighbors.

Commissioner Schaub discussed some possible conditions for the permit. She would like to add that Bill Carson (property owner) could revoke the permit at any time if he becomes uncomfortable with the situation, as well as the condition that the permit is based on approval from of the Health Department. Commissioner Petersen brought up the condition that the use could be void when the Russells move from the residence. Commissioner Malmstrom verified that he checked with the League to find out if it was legal to have a condition that states the use goes with the applicant, rather than the land. They said it was fine.

Kelly Chambers expressed her support for the Russells character and the business they are applying for.

Nathan Russell reminded that the Health Department has multiple restrictions and they frequently visit to make sure they are always in compliance.
